


2012 Cicero Competition Opens for Budding Classicists



Sixth formers keen to show off their knowledge of Latin and Classical Civilisation can now enter the 2012 International Cicero Competition which will take place next March.

The competition which takes the form of a written exam is held simultaneously at nominated centres across throughout the world.

Many sixth formers find the competition useful as a way of enhancing their personal statement which has become increasingly important in university applications. The event itself also offers the opportunity for students to meet up with other Classics students from their region and a video conference link on the day means students from around the world can talk to each other.

Refreshments are provided at the exam centres and students can win prizes of up to ± 150 , and incuding signed books and gift tokens.

The UK competition centres are in secondary schools in Liverpool, Malvern in Worcestershire, London, Edinburgh and Guernsey.
